□ 2. Anne Arundel County – Visit the Maryland State House in Annapolis and take a picture with the State House in the background.

□ 3. Baltimore County – Visit the Guinness Factory and take a picture in front of the main gate.

□ 4. Baltimore City – Visit Oriole Park at Camden Yards and take a picture standing in front of the Cal Ripken statue.

□ 5. Calvert County - Visit Calvert Marine Museum and take a picture standing in front of the Megaladon.

□ 6. Carroll County – Visit Baugher's Orchard in Westminster and take a picture with any Baugher's sign.

□ 7. Cecil County – Find Gilpin Falls Covered Bridge in North East, Maryland and take a picture with the bridge in the background.

□ 8. Charles County - Visit Port Tobacco Courthouse and take a picture with the courthouse in the background.

□ 9. Dorchester County – Visit Adventures of Harriet Tubman in Cambridge, MD and take a picture in front of the Harriet Tubman mural by Michael Rosato.
